

GRAMMAIRE	Whom / Who	Who is that masked man? (sujet) / The men, four of whom are ill, were indicted for fraud (COD)
GRAMMAIRE / CONJUGAISON	When I + PRESENT, I Will + VERBE	When I grow up , I will be famous
CONJUGAISON	There is / There are	There is a cat (singulier) / There are a lot of cats (pluriel)
GRAMMAIRE	I agree with + COD	I agree with you
VOCABULAIRE	Eventually / Basically	I'll do it eventually , but I'm busy right now. (finalement != éventuellement) / Basically you've got two choices... (en gros != basiquement)
CONJUGAISON	I'm used to + ING / I + PRESENT	I'm used to living on my own (accoutumance) / I play games (habitude)
VOCABULAIRE	Mildly / Gently	He talks a lot, which I find mildly annoying (faiblement / gentiment) / He broke the news gently (doucement / gentiment)
EXPRESSION / PREPOSITION	To bear the burden (of)	Iraqi children bear the burden of an uncalled-for war (porter le fardeau)
PREPOSITION / GRAMMAIRE	To depend on	It depends on the day / It loads a different background color depending on the time of the day
VOCABULAIRE / PREPOSITION	To relent on	Bossone said he thought the government would relent on the issues like GPS
VOCABULAIRE	A ski resort	A ski resort is a ski area
CONJUGAISON / PREPOSITION	A lack of + NOM / To lack + NOM	She has a lack of empathy / She lacks empathy
GRAMMAIRE	Despite + COD / In spite of + ING	She wasn't well, but despite this she went to work / In spite of the rain, we enjoyed our holiday
GRAMMAIRE / PREPOSITION	Thank you for + ING	Thank you for coming
VOCABULAIRE	An undergraduate student	I'm an undergraduate student in computer engineering
PREPOSITION	To be aware of + COD	I'm aware of the consequences
VOCABULAIRE	To flock (to)	Birds of a feather flock together / Tourists flock to Paris City
MOT DE LIAISON	In addition	In addition , I would say that ...
VOCABULAIRE	To be ham-handed	Some of the dishes arrived damaged after their ham-handed moving efforts
VOCABULAIRE / PREPOSITION	To affiliate with	Airport have affiliated with a union to obtain collective ...
VOCABULAIRE	Hardly / Barely / Likely	Hardly had they set off when ... / I can barely speak (à peine) - It's hardly likely (c'est peu probable) / A likely story ! (à d'autres !)
VOCABULAIRE	Merely	I'm merely a man, that means I'm just a man !
GRAMMAIRE	To remain + ADJECTIF	It is not right to remain silent when you witness something like this
VOCABULAIRE	Computing background	A computing background is required in order to get this job
VOCABULAIRE	Pointless / Useless / Needless	Their money was useless in this country / It is pointless doing things like that (inutile, rien apporté) / That was rude and needless (pas nécessaire)

EXPRESSION	A fish out of the water	She is so different like a fish out of the water
EXPRESSION	To thumb a ride	To thumb a ride is to hihitchhike
EXPRESSION	Sharp guy	He is very smart, a very sharp guy
EXPRESSION	The gift of gab	My flow is endless, I have the gift of gab
VOCABULAIRE / PREPOSITION	A bunch of + NOM / Plenty	"Can you bring a bunch of fruits ?" / "Yes, I have plenty " (pleins)
VOCABULAIRE	Go downstairs / go upstairs	She is on the 2nd floor, I'm going upstairs
VOCABULAIRE / PREPOSITION	To hang around with	She is always hanging around with the wrong guys
VOCABULAIRE	To be easygoing	I like living with her she is so easygoing
VOCABULAIRE	(Struggle) to make a living	Refugee women struggle to make a living in Malaysia
EXPRESSION	To tackle a problem	Finland and Canada tackle diabetes problem
EXPRESSION	Premenstrual syndrome (PMS)	PMS is sometimes referred to PMT or Premenstrual Tension
GRAMMAIRE / PREPOSITION	To be careful (of + COD)	Be careful of what you wish for
VOCABULAIRE	To run a company / a business	How to set up and run your own business ?
VOCABULAIRE	To turn 30	When I turn 30 , I will buy a car
GRAMMAIRE	To pick up + NOM / To pick + NOM + up	I pick you up at 5:00 PM
VOCABULAIRE	Efficient / Convinient	This device is so great, it is both convinient and efficient
EXPRESSION	Lame (ADJ)	That is so a lame excuse
VOCABULAIRE	To catch up	It would be hard to catch up all that we have done since 2000
PREPOSITION	To behave like	You shouldn't behave like a child
EXPRESSION	Head over heels	To fall head over heels in love with someone
GRAMMAIRE	There is no + NOM	There is no chance you could ...
GRAMMAIRE / PREPOSITION	To be comfortable with	I'm not comfortabe with this idea
VOCABULAIRE	To take + NOM + for granted	I always take my ability for granted , but I'm wrong
